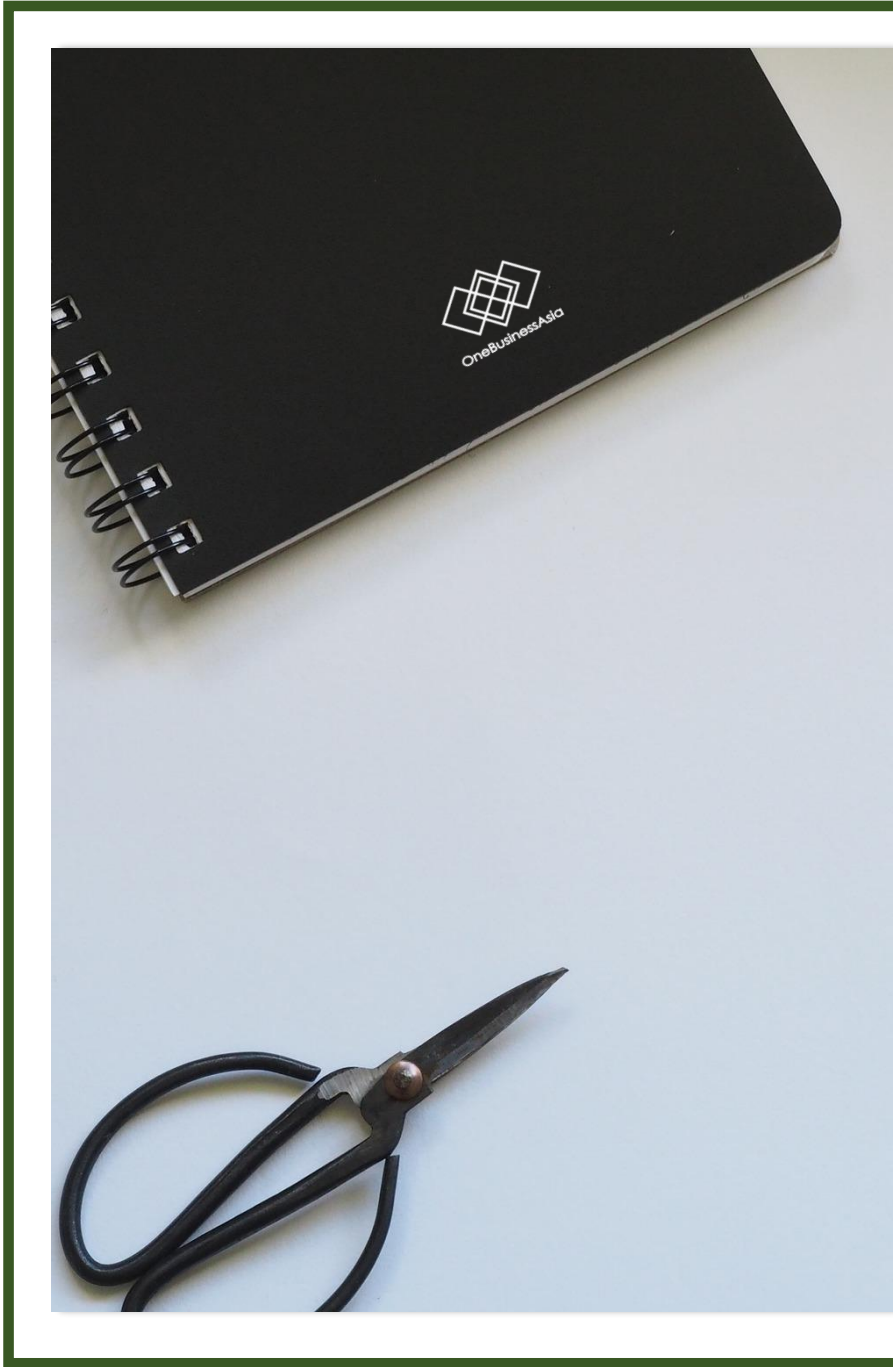

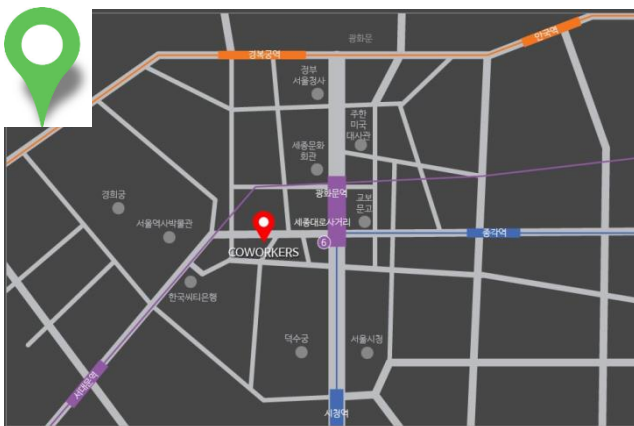

Mr. Matthew Au

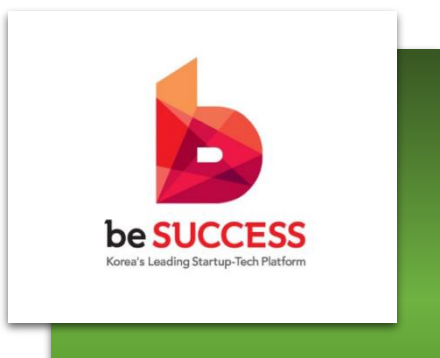
